Cement Production / Local Market Million Consumption



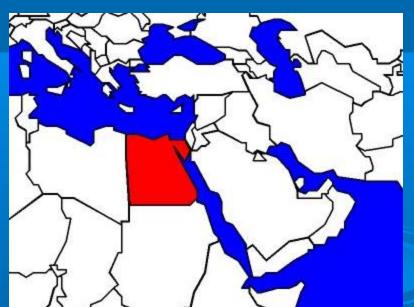

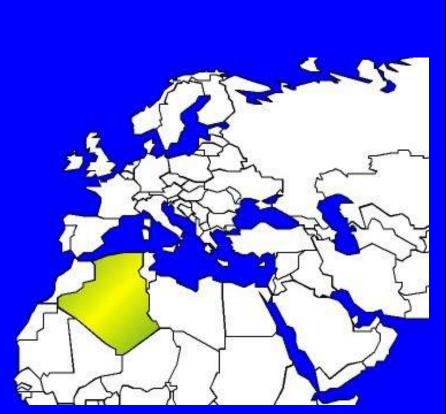

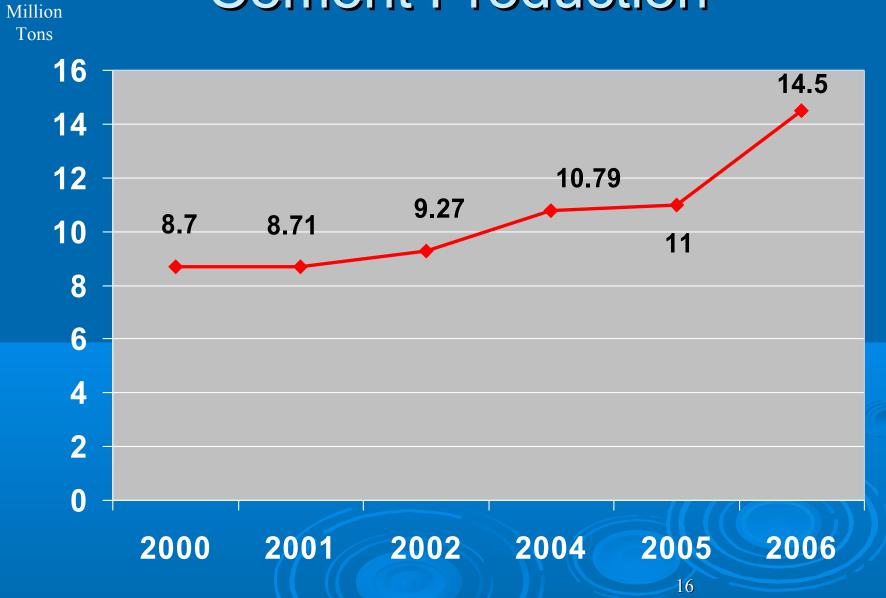

- Orascom is adding a new gray cement line in CIBA, with capacity 2.5m Mt to be coming in production by end of 2007, taking advantage of being close to 2 ports, and reflecting the strong interest of Orascom in Algeria as a possible export market.
- ASEC are starting building a new plant in Jelfa with capacity of 1.5 m Mt expected to be operating by 2009.
- Lafarge and ASEC are showing big interest in acquiring government owned cement plants.

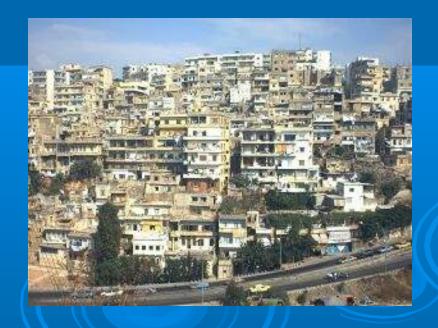

Lebanon Now

Loss in July war reaches about 3.6 billion \$, damages in infrastructure and housing sector.

Cement Industry was going a healthy increase in Jan-July 2006, with average increase of 46% compared to previous years.

Three Cement producers:

- Holcim : produce about 1.85m Mt/y

Cimentrie Nationale : produce about 1.6m Mt/y

Sibline Cement : produce about 0.8m Mt/y

Exports are about 711,000Mt of cement and 172,000 Mt clinker in 2006

Export markets: Syria, Cyprus, Iraq & Turkey

Lebanon Tomorrow

Cimenterie Nationale : is investing 100 million \$ to upgrade facility in Chekka to be completed next May, to reach 2.5m Mt production from 1.7m Mt now.

Semapa SCPS – owned Portugese cement company "Secil" has acquired another 21.86% more in cement Sibline raising its share to 50.5%

Lebanese market needs about 750,000Mt over the next 3 years for reconstruction

Continuing illegal quantities of cement to Syria to increase to about 750,000Mt/y.

Legal exported quantities to Syria and Iraq to increase from 0.9m Mt to reach 1.5mMt / 2 m Mt.

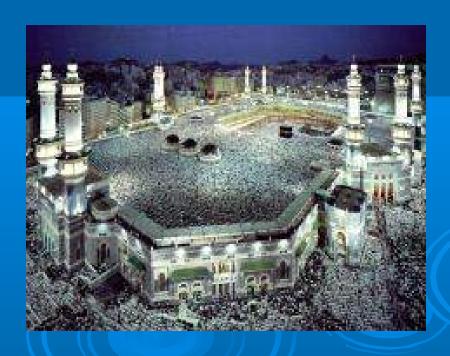

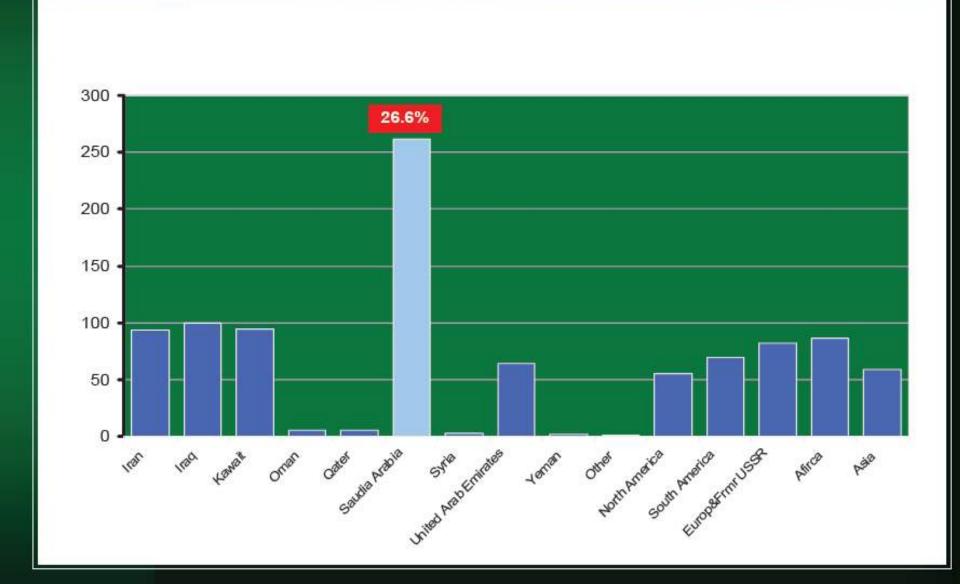

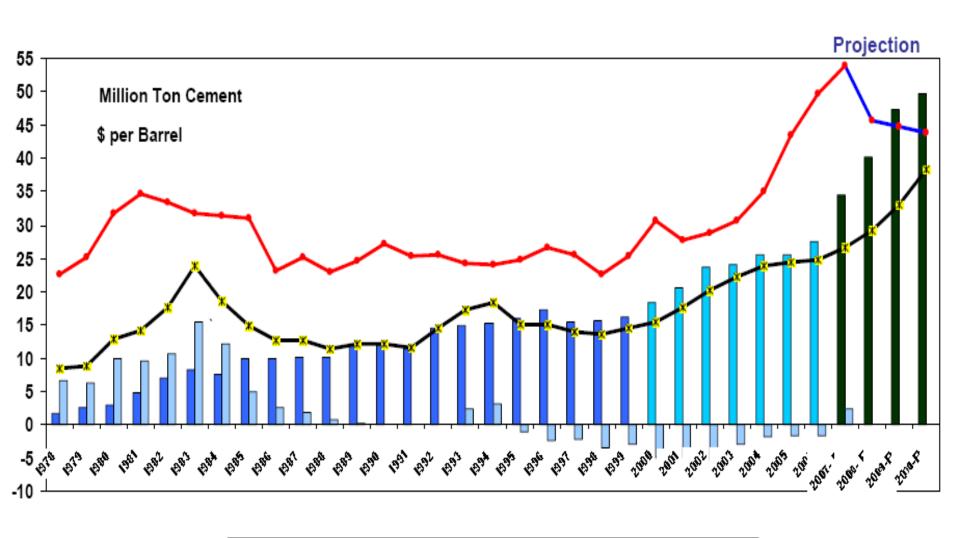


World Oil reserves

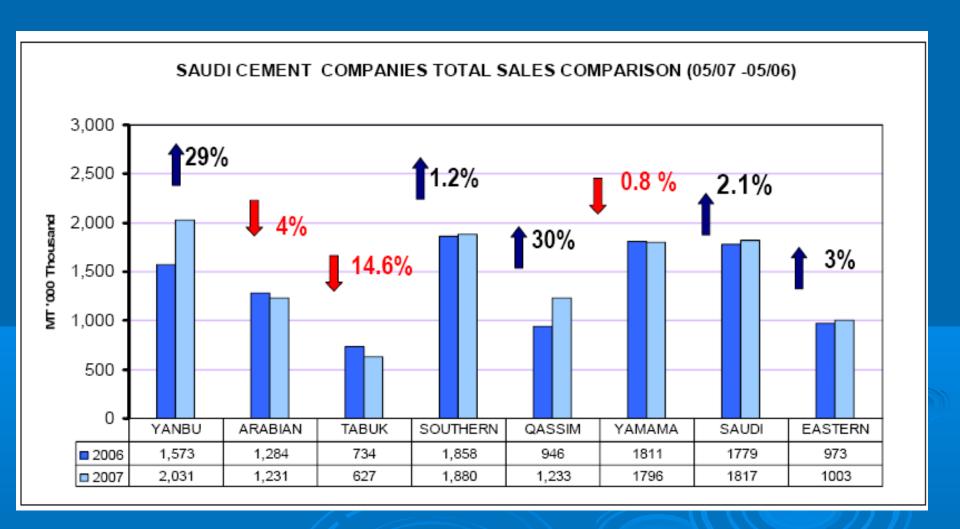

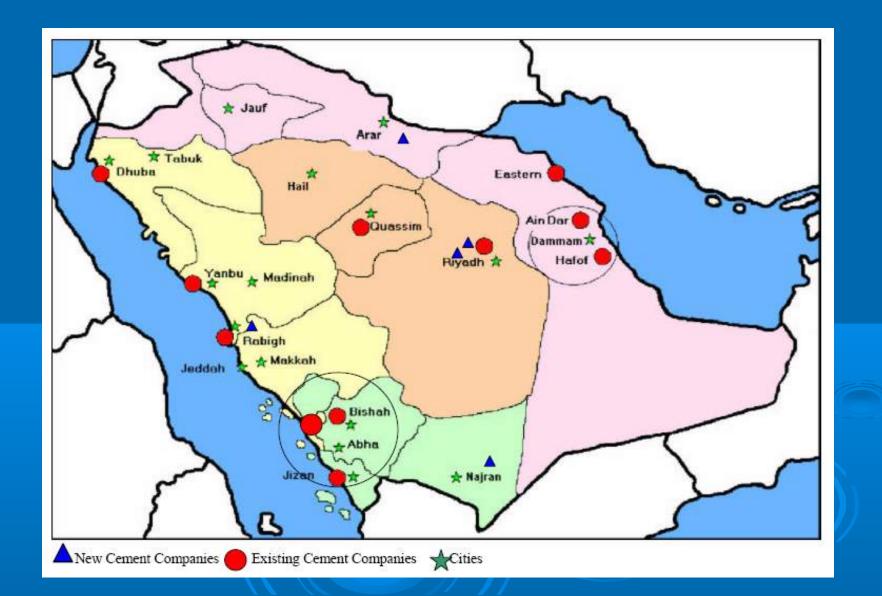

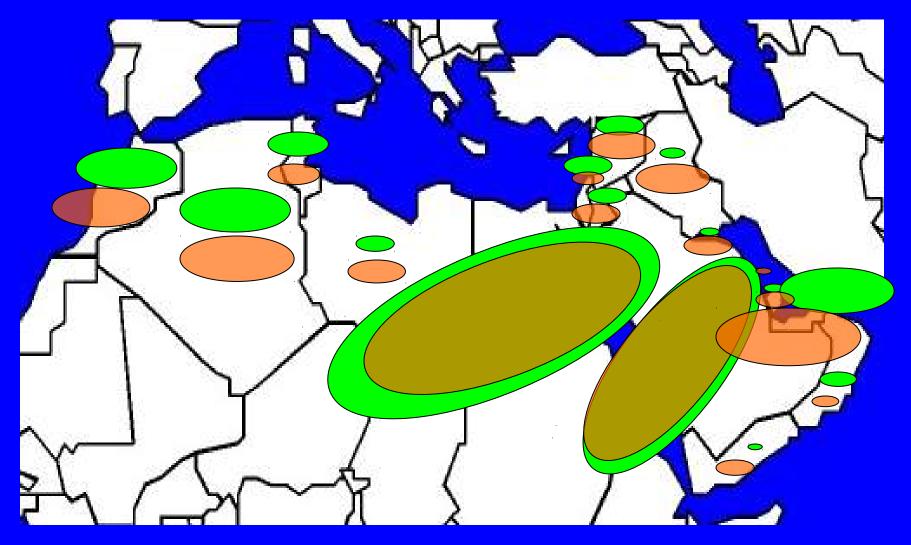

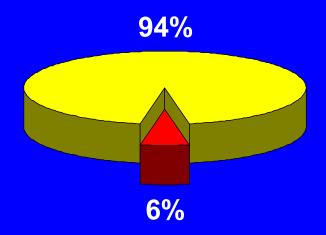

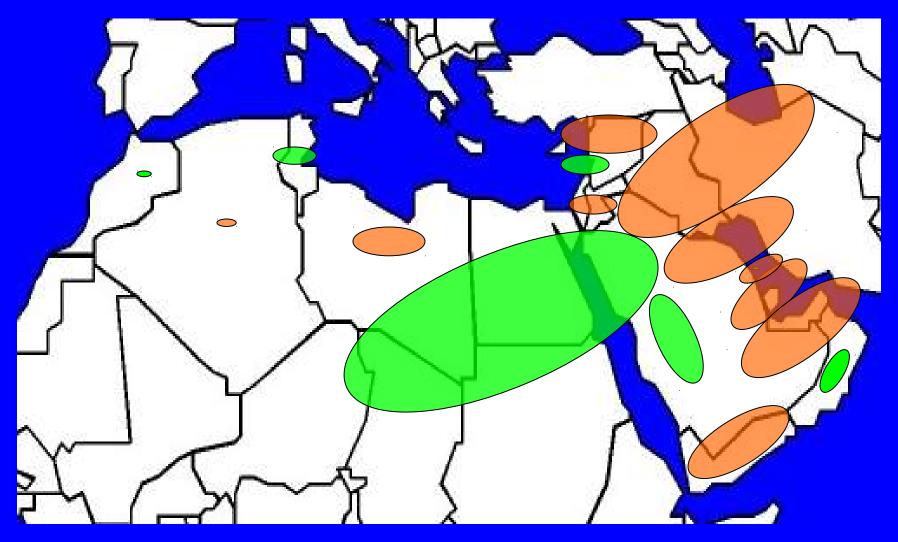

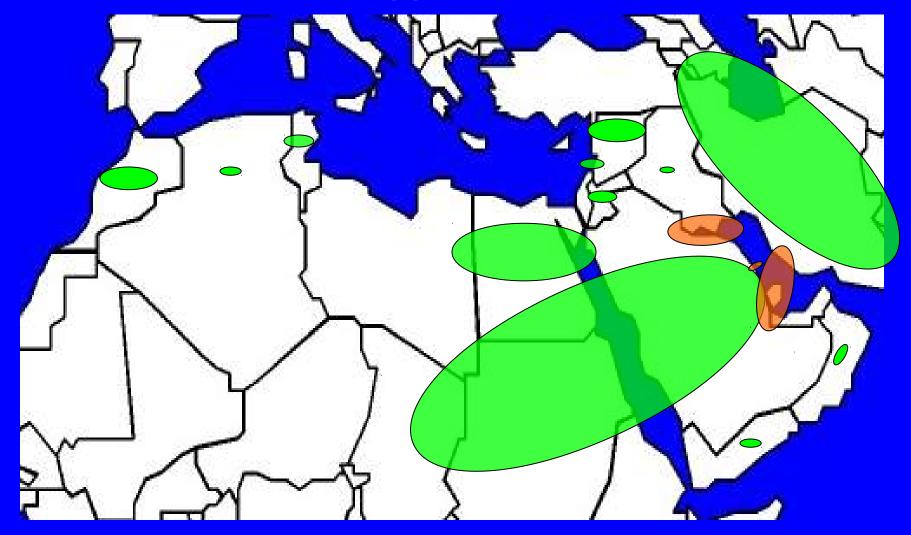

Expected Cement Exports / Imports)(2010



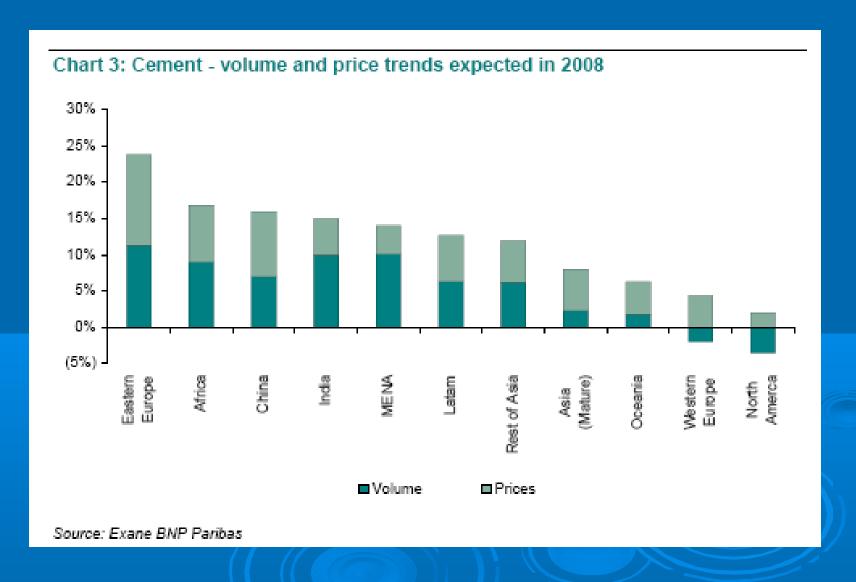




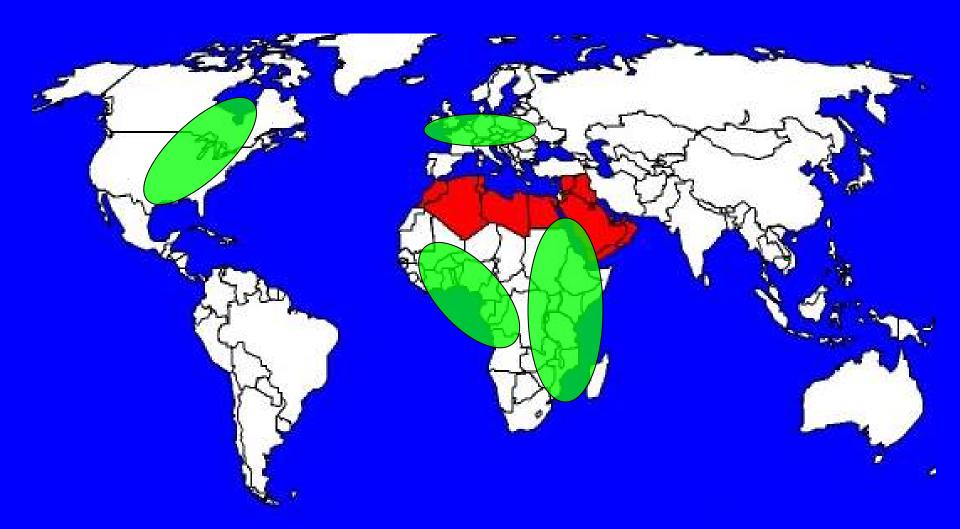
Oil Prices Movement (2000-2010)
